Chelsfield Vista. During 2018 and with support from The Chelsfield Village Society, we have rebuilt the viewpoint on Chelsfield Common. You can find more details on our notice boards or our website, but please do go and visit and admire the view.

Bulb Planting. Each year we add to the already extensive collection of spring bulbs that you will see in the woods up and down Warren Road. In 2017 we planted daffodils and crocus at the junction of old and new Warren Roads, and in 2018 we planted further daffodils and bluebells by the railings at Chelsfield Station and at the Chelsfield Vista.
