Also in 2012 we held two woodland clearing sessions, one in Aspen Spring Woods and the other in lower Warren Road. This involved the removal of dead branches, garden waste and ivy. With the help of the pupils and staff from Warren Road School, we planted bulbs in the wooded areas and open spaces. We hope you will appreciate the results this Spring.

We have expressed our concern to Bromley Council regarding the additional commuter parking in Old Warren Road. The additional parking is a cause of parking at Knockholt station now being charged for and commuters instead are travelling from Chelsfield. Cars parking on the grassed area are damaging the green and are also preventing residents from accessing their driveways. The Council is considering various options and we hope that this issue will be resolved later in the year.
